We work hard to overturn this perception.

The challenges that face most nonprofits in human services are lack of funding and lack of workforce. Since HOPE Agency cannot change the climate of funding regulations, more effort has been placed on how to keep our existing quality workforce. By investing time and effort on retention, less money is needed on turnover, which costs companies across the spectrum millions of dollars every year.

Relationships are essential. Relationships with employees and participants and their families are built upon mutual trust and respect. Relationships with community employers opens up career possibilities for supported individuals. Relationships with local educational organizations engages potential future workforce.

2019 was a year of growth for HOPE Agency. Enrollment in programs increased by 40% despite changes in Managed Care Provider Organizations. As we leave 2019 behind, we are optimistic about a year of continued growth and community awareness. All individuals have value and talents and we want the Greater Des Moines area to notice this as well.
